

Ski Trail Etiquette at Little Cataraqui Creek Conservation Area



In the winter, when conditions permit, Trails 1, 2, 3 and 4 are groomed and track set for classic cross-country skiing.

Walkers are permitted to use these trails, but should avoid walking in the ski track to keep it in good condition and to allow skiers to pass.

Trail 5 and the service roads are available for walking and snowshoeing.

When skiing on the trails please follow cross-country ski trail etiquette.

- Ski on the right hand side of the trail.
- Ski single file and not side-by-side.
- Give descending skiers the right of way.
- Yield the track to faster skiers or skiers saying “track” by allowing them to pass on the left hand side.
- Don’t obstruct the ski trails or intersection. Move off the track if you fall or while taking a break.
- Don’t stop where you are not visible to on-coming skiers.
- If you are skiing with a dog, make sure it is leashed and under control. Be sure to clean up after your pet.
