

Winter Walking and Snowshoeing at Little Cataraqui Creek Conservation Area



Winter walking and snowshoeing are great ways to get outdoors and enjoy the winter.

Our trails are used in the winter by a variety of different users including skiers, walkers and snowshoers.

In the winter, when conditions permit, Trails 1, 2, 3 and 4 are groomed and track set for cross-country skiing.

Please do not walk or snowshoe in the ski tracks.

Walk or snowshoe in the middle of the trail and step off the trail to allow skiers to pass.

Trail 5, the service road to the dam is not groomed or track set and the service road to the sugar bush is available for walking and snowshoeing.

If you are bringing your dog, it must be leashed and under control at all times in the Conservation Area.
