**Little Cataraqui Creek Conservation Area boardwalk to be
closed for construction**

Kingston – The boardwalk north of the Outdoor Centre at Little Cataraqui Creek Conservation Area will be closed for construction beginning on Tuesday, July 2. Access to the area east of the Outdoor Centre will also be restricted due to construction activity.

The project will involve demolition of the existing boardwalk and construction of a new boardwalk in the same location. The work is expected to take most of the summer to complete.

Funding assistance for this project was provided by the Kingston-Frontenac Rotary Club.

The boardwalk serves as an access to Little Cataraqui Creek Conservation Area's 14 km of trails. Alternative access to Trails 1 and 5 is available from the service road north of the warming huts. Trail 4 can be accessed across from the CRCA Administration Office or from the picnic area near the dam.
