Cataraqui Trail parking lot at Highway 15 to be closed this week

Kingston – The Cataraqui Trail parking lot at Highway 15 will be closed this week for culvert replacement, weather permitting. The work is being undertaken by Cruickshank Construction on behalf of the Ministry of Transportation.

Parking at this location, which is north of Elgin and south of Crosby, will not be available for the duration of the project.

The closest access point with parking available is at Chaffey's Locks.

Trail access for hikers and cyclists will be maintained. Please observe posted signs as well as direction from local safety personnel during the construction period.

The Cataraqui Trail is a 104 km long multi-use trail along a former railway line that goes from Smiths Falls to Strathcona (near Napanee). Permitted uses on the Trail include hiking, cycling, skiing, horseback riding and snowmobiling with a valid permit.
