## Parrott's Bay Conservation Area north-east trails closed for construction

**Kingston** – The Cataraqui Region Conservation Authority is planning to do some trail reconstruction along trails 5 and 6 beginning the week of November 24, 2014. Portions of these trails will be closed until the construction is completed.

This affects the northeast part of the Parrott's Bay Conservation Area between Taylor-Kidd Boulevard and Parrott's Bay. None of the trails on the west side of the bay or the Highway 33 entrance will be affected by the construction. (See map below.)

"The trail work will include replacing three culverts plus drainage and surface improvements on the parts of trails 5 and 6 that cross a wetland area," explained Steve Knechtel, CRCA General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer.

Depending on the weather, the work should be completed by the end of November.

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
