Seasonal Dam Operations Commence in CRCA Watershed

Kingston – The Cataraqui Region Conservation Authority (CRCA) would like to inform the public that local dam operators in the CRCA watershed are performing routine seasonal operations in preparation of spring runoff.

Dam operators' year-round activities include lowering controlled lakes levels at this time of year, increasing storage volume in the lakes, in anticipation of spring snowmelt and the runoff that results.

The public is reminded that expected flow increases, along with cold, fast moving water, and thin ice around dams are hazards that should be avoided.
